



What a trip it has been! So few folks auditioned for this show and yet it seems we were able to find just the right people for these 6 roles, and each of them worked so hard to make the performance memorable. Lines were learned early on so that we could concentrate on the development of each character. What a pleasure for the director to be able to reach for the subtleties of each interaction because the actors had already created the basics.

No one gets paid, no one will be written up in the local paper, no one will use this role as a stepping stone to go on to Broadway. Yet, each one gave his or her all. Why? It's the play. *Crimes of the Heart* is so well-written, and the characters are so interesting and full of nuance that each actor wanted to do the work to make his or her role come to life. Some of the folks you see on stage had been waiting years to play this character.

And then there is the crew. Each one coming to rehearsals, completing the myriad tasks required to produce a show, and doing it for the love of theater. These are the folks who make it possible to bring such a production to Wolfeboro.

My goal was to bring a Pulitzer Prize winning play to the stage so you could see it here in Wolfeboro, since not all of us are able to go to Boston or New York (and who can afford the professional stage these days.) I hoped that we could do a creditable job for you, and my hopes have been more than exceeded. I think you will find this production funny, moving, sad, frightening, and memorable. Much of your enjoyment will be due to the playwright's work, and much of it will be due to the extraordinary efforts of the actors and actresses. Bravo to them.
